Additional Questions and Answers

Q. How are unsuitable soils to be handled?

A. Unsuitable soils to be removed from the site will be accepted by the City of Kingsland Public Works Department

Undercut areas not shown in the Plans when directed by the Engineer will be paid in accordance with GDOT Standard Specifications 2021 Section 210.5c

Q. What are the procedures for burning?

A. Any on-site burning will require a burn permit.

Section 18-4 of City of Kingsland Ordinance:

“Burning of refuse, building materials, brush, land clearing residue or any other waste materials, except in an approved incinerator or heating device, is prohibited unless a special permit has been obtained from the fire chief's office authorizing the burning.”

Call City Hall 912-729-5613.

The Georgia Forestry Commission will have ultimate authority and authorization.

Q. What are the testing requirements?

A. Follow general practices. No specific independent testing is mandated.

Q. The bid item list shows 5.92 ac Temporary Grass, 5.92 ac Permanent Grass and 28,629 sy sod. Please clarify. There is no sod in the Erosion Control Drawings.

A. All areas between the edge of pavement and the ROW boundaries are to be sodded. You can delete Temporary and Permanent grass.

Q. Does the RCP on this project require a GDOT stamp?

A. Yes
